Mesa County, Colorado, held at the Court House, in Grand Junction
on Wednesday the first day of October A. D. 19 52,
there were present:

when the following proceedings, among others, were had and done, to-wit:

RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE
COUNTY OF MESA, STATE OF COLORADO, CREATING THE
COLLBRAN CEMETERY DISTRICT IN SAID COUNTY

WHEREAS' There has been presented to this Board petitions signed
by 243 residents of Mesa County representing that each person signing
the same was a taxpaying elector, and requesting that a cemetery district
be created in the County of Mesa within the existing boundaries of the
Collbran District, described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 5, Township 9 South,
Range 95 West 6th Principal Meridian, South 5 1/2 miles to the East Quarter
corner of Section 32, Township 9 South, Range 95 West 6th Principal
Meridian, thence West 1 1/2 miles to the center of Section 31, thence
North 1 1/2 miles to the South quarter corner Section 19, thence west
one-half mile to the Southwest corner said Section 19, thence South
2 1/2 miles to the west quarter corner Section 6, Township 10 South, Range
95 west 6th Principal Meridian, thence East one-half mile, thence
south one-half mile, thence East one-half mile to the Southeast corner
said Section 6, thence south three-quarters mile, thence east seven-
eighths mile, thence south one-quarter mile, thence east one-eighth
mile to the southeast corner Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 95
west 6th Principal Meridian, thence south one mile to the southeast
corner Section 17, thence west one-half mile, thence south one-half mile
thence east one-half mile, thence south one-half mile to the southeast
corner Section 20, Township 10 South, Range 95 West 6th Principal
Meridian, thence south approximately 8 miles to the boundary line between
Mesa County and Delta County, thence northeasterly along said boundary
line to the east line of Township 10 South, Range 92 West, 6th Principal
Meridian, thence north along the Township line approximately 1 1/2 miles
to the boundary line between Mesa County and Garfield County, thence
west along said boundary line approximately 22 miles to the West line
of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 95 west, 6th Principal Meridian,
thence south to the point of beginning.

said area comprising School Districts 17, 12, 22, 6, 21, 42, 24 and
14 as presently established.

AND WHEREAS, The Board finds that pursuant to the definition of
"Taxpaying elector" as set forth in Section 17, Chapter 59 C.S.A. said
petitions have been signed by 243 taxpaying electors resident within
the boundaries of said proposed district,

The Board further finds that there are 484 resident taxpayers within
said proposed district, and that accordingly said petitions have been
signed by a majority of the taxpaying electors resident in said proposed
district as provided by statute.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That a Cemetery District be and it is hereby established within the boundaries of the above described lands and premises; that the name of said district shall be Collbran Cemetery District,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That a certified copy of this resolution be forthwith filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder of Mesa County
