

Know all Men by these Presents, That we S. G. Lane, E. W. Pettit, J. D. Turner, C. V. Carroll and G. J. D. Williams

residents of the State of Colorado, have associated ourselves together as a Corporation under the name and style of The Elmwood Cemetery Association for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Colorado, and in accordance with the provisions of the laws of said State, we do hereby make, execute and acknowledge in Duplicate this certificate in writing of our intention so to become a body corporate, under and by virtue of said laws.

FIRST. The corporate name and style of our said Company shall be The Elmwood Cemetery Association

SECOND. The object for which our said Company is formed and incorporated is for the purpose of procuring and establishing a cemetery or place of sepulture, and in furtherance of the said object, to purchase, hold and convey real and personal estate, and to mortgage and encumber the same whenever it is necessary to provide means to carry on the business of the Association, by way of incumbrance

THIRD. The capital stock of our said Company is Five Thousand (\$5000.00) dollars to be divided into Five Hundred shares of Ten dollars for each share, and said stock shall be assessable.

FOURTH. Our said Company is to exist for the term of Twenty years.

FIFTH. The affairs and management of our said Company is to be under the control of five directors, to wit: S. G. Lane, E. W. Pettit, J. D. Turner, C. V. Carroll and G. J. D. Williams are hereby selected to act as said Directors and to manage the affairs and concerns of said Company for the first year of its existence

SIXTH. The operations of our said Company will be carried on in the County of Mesa

and the principal place and business office of said Company shall be located in the Town of Frisita County of Mesa and State of Colorado aforesaid.

SEVENTH. The Directors shall have power to make such prudential by-laws as they may deem proper for the management of the affairs of this Company according to the statute in such case made and provided.
