to the said party of the first part, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents, does grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Mesa, and State of Colorado, to wit: Lot numbered Sixty Nine numbered,

in the Town of Grand Junction, as shown by the Grand Junction Town Company's Original Plat of said Town, on file in the office of the Recorder of the County of Mesa and State of Colorado, and of said Town, 16<sup>th</sup> 1884 with

I. I) of Division 13 of the cemetery grounds and being 610 feet long east and west and 290 ft wide north and south - the same being for cemetery purposes

And the said THE GRAND JUNCTION TOWN COMPANY, party of the first part, for itself, its successors and assigns, does covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, its Successors and assigns, that at the time of the executing and delivery of these presents it was well seized of the premises above conveyed, as of good, sure, perfect, absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in law, in fee simple, and has good right, full power and lawful authority to grant, bargain, sell and convey the same, in manner and form aforesaid, and that the same are free and clear from all former and other grants, bargains, sales, assessments and incumbrances of whatever kind or nature soever, except liens and taxes which may have accrued since the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May A. D. 1884:

and the above bargained premises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, its successors heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said party of the first part shall and will WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND.
