

DROWNED.

Three People are Precipitated into the Grand River.

George Allen, George Warren and Willie Warren Meet a Watery Grave.

Fruita, Colo., May 25.—Yesterday evening about 6 o'clock while George Allan, George Warren and his son, Willie Warren, were endeavoring to cross the Grand River, at this point, from the south side, on a temporary tram car used on the ferry cable, the anchorage at the north end of the cable gave away and threw all three of them into the center of the stream which is very high and swift, and they were drowned before any aid could reach them from either side.

There were three or four parties living on this side of the river, and Mrs. Allan, who lives on the opposite side, and Mr. W. R. Gale of Delta, who was at Allan's at the time, were all eye witnesses to the accident, but were unable to render any assistance whatever.

Allan leaves a wife, and George Warren leaves a wife and two small children. Willie Warren was a boy about 15 years of age.

None of the bodies of the victims have been recovered as yet. F. H. BARRY.
