

Death of S. D. Lingo.

S. D. Lingo, the agent and operator for the Rio Grande at Iola, died yesterday afternoon at the Rio Grande hospital of a complication of diseases. Some time since Mr. Lingo was brought to the hospital for treatment, but his troubles grew steadily worse until relieved by death.

The funeral services will be held tomorrow at 2 p m. at the Episcopal church and the interment will be made at Fairview. The deceased was a member of the O. R. T. and had been in service on the second and third divisions of the Rio Grande for five years.

Deceased was aged 25 years and leaves a wife to mourn his loss. He was well known at Montrose and Grand Junction, where he was in the employ of the company as an operator, and was a man highly respected by all who knew him.

His mother-in-law, Mrs. Huston, arrived Monday morning from Cripple Creek and attended him at the time of his death. His wife has been attending him during his sickness.
