

GEORGE BLISS, RANCHER AT GATEWAY, DIES

George Albert Bliss, rancher who had resided in the Dolores river district for less than three months, passed away Friday noon at his home in Gateway. His death culminated three years of poor health.

Mr. Bliss was born Aug. 22, 1880, at Bliss, Idaho, and resided in Idaho until November, 1939, when he moved to Gateway.
