

Sometime during Thursday the body of the late George A. Crawford, the founder of this city, which has reposed since his burial in 1891 in the vault of of the Masonic order, was removed to the high prominence, overlooking this city, immediately back of the present Orchard Mesa cemetry. The site is one of the most beautiful in all this valley and overlooks this city and the valley of the Grand river, from the mout's of the canon to a long distance to the west and was the place that the deceased had designated to his executors as the place where he desired finally to tay. A vault has been erec ed by John J. Lumsden a d while not of any great ornate beauty. ie substantial and will last centuries. The pl ce selected for the last interment of the remains of George A. Crawford w s a site picked out by himself and is at a point near where he first beheld the beautiful Grand valley stretching away toward the Wasatch range of mountains
