DIED: Of typhoid fever at Grand Junction, Thursday morning, October 4th, 1888, Miss Edith Haynes.

The diseased was a sister of our old-time citizen, Badger Haynes, and arrived in our city last winter from North Carolina. She was a consistant Christian lady, a member of the Baptist church, a teacher in the Sabbath school, and respected and loved by all who knew her. The funeral took place on Thursday afternoon and was conducted by Rev. J. J. Hill.
