

**Death of George Washington.**

George Washington, an Apache boy, aged about 19 years, died this morning at Teller institute, between 3 and 4 o'clock, of pneumonia.

The deceased had been sick only about one week succumbing rapidly to the ravages of the disease.

The interment will take place this afternoon from the school, and all the honors possible that can be conferred upon him by his schoolmates will be rendered.

George Washington, the dead Indian boy, was one of the best beloved by his schoolmates of all the children at the Teller institute. He became a member of the school about four years ago, coming from the San Carlos agency. He was a the son of one of the principal chiefs of the Apache nation. He was a bright and promising student, whose daily life was a model and a bright example to all the Indian boys and girls.

The deceased was well known in this city, where he had many warm friends among the younger population who will read of his death with much regret.

The sudden death of George Washington, coming so quickly after the death of Allen Thurman, has been a matter of keen sorrow to Captain Lemmon, superintendent of the institute, and his corps of assistants. Everything that medical science could devise was done for the relief of the boy, but without avail.
