

**"PA" WHITE IS
DEATH VICTIM**

**Returns From Soldiers' Home
to Die; Will Be Buried
in Whitewater.**

Joshua White, familiarly and affectionately known to his hundreds of local friends as "Pa" White, passed away last evening at the Nelson sanitarium after a lingering illness and which every known human aid had failed to relieve. Mr. White, together with his daughter, Mrs. Matt Casto, of the Unaweep canon, arrived last night from the California coast.

Mr. White was 75 years old, being born in September, 1839, in Ohio. Throughout the Civil war he fought in the Fortieth Ohio and has been a member of the G. A. R. here. He has spent several months at the Soldiers' home in Sawtelle, Calif. He arrived in the valley in 1888 and has ever since made his home on his ranch in the Unaweep above Whitewater. In accordance with his last wish he will be buried in Whitewater cemetery near his wife, who passed away 28 years ago. Mrs. Casto left here a week ago to bring her father home.

Loved and respected by all who knew him "Pa" White's demise will be keenly felt by those who were familiar with his sterling character and absolute honesty. He leaves two daughters, Mrs. John T. Vallett of Stockton, Kansas, and Mrs. Matt Casto, of the Unaweep, and one son, Frank White, of Moab. Both sister and brother have been notified of his death. The funeral will be some time this week in Whitewater.
