William J. Anthony, 1920 Lands End Road, Whitewater, died Wednesday in his home. He was 67.

Mr. Anthony, a resident of the Whitewater area for nine years, was the owner and operator of his own concrete company.

He was born March 15, 1921, to Adolphus and Mary Carol Anthony in Brooklyn, N.Y., where he spent his childhood and graduated from high school.

Mr. Anthony served with the U.S. Navy during World War II.

He married Catherine Louise Mueller on June 21, 1944, in Brooklyn. Mrs. Mueller, a registered nurse at Community Hospital, survives.

Mr. Anthony moved from New York to Colorado Springs in 1963, to Grand Junction in 1978 and in 1980 to Whitewater.

Other survivors include three sons, Paul W. of Collbran, Thomas J. of Littlefork, Minn., and Lance J. of Colorado Springs; three daughters, Patricia A. Barger of Colorado Springs, Catherine L. Decker of Widefield and Karen L. Kuxhausen of Whitewater; a sister, Ethel Shea of Langmont, N.C.; and 12 grandchildren. Two brothers are deceased.
