(a short business meeting follows the noon meeting)

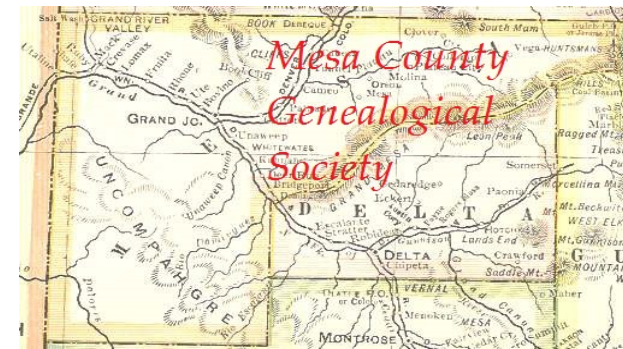
